

## Information Release

**Montego Bay, Jamaica, April 22, 2009** - MJB Airports Limited (MJB) has completed a preliminary investigation into the armed intrusion of April 19, 2009 and has delivered this initial report to the Minister of Transport. This investigation used Closed Circuit Television (CCTV) recordings and statements from our contracted Airport Security Team and Operations personnel. This preliminary investigation shows that:

- Our unarmed security team reacted properly and followed their procedures, as per the civil-aviation approved MJB Security Program, when confronted by an armed intruder;
- The airport security personnel maintained visual surveillance of the armed intruder until the Jamaica Constabulary Force (JCF) responded to the scene;
- The armed JCF response to the incident was exceptional, exceeding many International standards.

MJB Airports Limited is now conducting a more detailed and exhaustive report in order to gain as much knowledge as possible to apply to future plans. MJB Airports Limited will continue to work closely with the Jamaica Civil Aviation Authority (JCAA) and government ministries, as well as the Jamaica Constabulary Force (JCF) in their investigations.

### Background Information

MJB Airports Limited (MJB) is responsible for the management and day to day operation of Sangster International Airport under a thirty (30) year concession agreement with the Government of Jamaica, which commenced in 2003. MJB Airports Limited is a partnership between Abertis (Spain) with a share of 74.5% and Vancouver Airport Services (YVRAS) (Canada) with a share of 25.5%.

MJB is responsible for the provision of security personnel, procedures and equipment in accordance with the concession agreement. Port Security Corps is contracted by MJB to provide airport screening and security.

MJB works very closely with the Jamaica Constabulary Force (JCF) which provides the armed security at Sangster International Airport.
