Emergency Response Services Manager

The span of responsibility encompasses the organization and direction of the aircraft rescue and fire-fighting services at SIA, the ability of the service to respond to emergencies; the maintenance of standard and specialized apparatus and equipment, the provision of a fire free escape route for the safe evacuation of passengers and crew and the achievement of performance standards and compliance with the MBJ Concession Agreement. The incumbent is on call 24 hours.

Minimum Qualifications and Experience:

- Bachelor's Degree in Fire Science, Business Administration, Engineering or similar discipline
