Monday October 3, 2016, 9:00a.m. - MBJ Airports Limited, operators of Sangster International Airport, continues to monitor the projected path of Hurricane Matthew and wishes to advise that the airport remains open and operational until further notice.

MBJ wishes to advise the public that the following airlines have confirmed cancellations for **Monday October 3, 2016**.

Cayman Airways – flight 621 to Grand Cayman
Caribbean Airlines – all flights into and out of Montego Bay
Spirit – flight NK833/270 into and out of Montego Bay
Southwest – all flights into and out of Montego Bay
Thomson Airways – flight 094/5 from/to London Gatwick

WestJet – flight 2702/3 from/to Toronto. WestJet passengers schedule to depart Monday October 3, 2016 are being rebooked on flight 2701 to depart Montego Bay at 12:40 and flight 2703 to depart at 2:10 pm on Tuesday October 4, 2016.

The travelling public is encouraged to contact their respective airlines directly regarding flight operations before arriving at the airport. Passengers booked on cancelled flights are advised to contact their travel agents or airlines for rebooking options.
