### **Cancellations:**

**Caribbean Airlines – Cancelled** Flight 011 to New York for **Sunday October 2, 2016**

**Southwest – Cancelled** all flights into and out of Montego Bay for **Monday October 3, 2016**

**Spirit – Cancelled** all flights into and out of Montego Bay for **Monday October 3, 2016**

### **Replacements:**

**Southwest – Montego Bay to Orlando departing at 9:00am**

**Southwest – Montego Bay to Baltimore departing at 4:00 pm**

**Spirit – Montego Bay to Ft Lauderdale departing at 2:08 pm**
