FRONTIER AIRLINES EXPANDS CONNECTIONS FROM THE USA TO JAMAICA WITH THE COMMENCEMENT OF NEW SERVICES FROM TAMPA, FLORIDA.

Montego Bay, Jamaica, 24 June 2022/MBJ Media// Sangster International Airport (SIA), Jamaica's leading gateway to the world operated by MBJ Airports Limited, welcomed Frontier Airlines' new non-stop flight from Tampa, Florida.

The arriving flight landed to a spectacular water arch salute from MBJ's Emergency Response Service and lively entertainment courtesy of a local Mento Band. The six (6) crew and 140 passengers disembarking the inaugural flight were extended a warm island welcome by Councilor Richard Vernon, Deputy Mayor of Montego Bay; Audley Deidrick, President of Airports Authority of Jamaica (AAJ), Donovan White; Director of Tourism, Odette Dyer, Regional Director, JTB Jamaica, Shane Munroe, Chief Executive Officer MBJ Airports Limited; Nadine Spence, Chair Jamaica Hotel & Tourist Association, Montego Bay Chapter; and other industry representatives.

Frontier Airlines' flight F984 will operate two (2) weekly non-stop services from Tampa to MBJ on Mondays and Fridays. This new service from Tampa represents the 5th route added by the airline to MBJ since introducing scheduled service to the airport in May 2021.

President of Airports Authority of Jamaica Audley Deidrick stated that "The Airports Authority of Jamaica (AAJ) is very pleased to welcome Frontier Airlines on its Inaugural flight from Tampa, Florida to the Sangster International Airport (SIA), Montego Bay. We look forward to their continued growth in service to Jamaica, from various destinations in the United States."

This is an extremely proud moment for us to continue to expand flight service out of North America, stated the Director of Tourism, Donovan White. "This is the fifth gateway that Frontier has opened for us (Jamaica) out of the USA, to include Philadelphia, Miami, Atlanta, and Miami. Mr. White also stated that "This makes us feel confident that we're not only growing day by day with our existing partners, but we also have partners who are coming into the market place and seeing the destination being a successful one to do business with, therefore adding more seats, flights, and routes".
