




Traffic Evolution – Passengers (m)






2017 YTD Passengers per Month (k)






Traffic Seasonality – Passengers (k)





Traffic Evolution – Aircraft Movements






2017 Aircraft Movements (Jan-Aug)






2017 YTD Aircraft per Month






Traffic Evolution – Cargo (t)






Cargo 2017 Jan-Aug (t)






Top 10 Routes Jan-Aug 2017 (k pax)











Project to be executed in five (5) phases over ten(10) months commencing October 2017.






Runway extension - Component 1 Relocation of Public Roads and Utilities






Runway extension – Component 2 RESAs & extension






Runway extension – Component 3 Thresholds & Navaids






Runway extension – Component 4 Taxiway "E" expansion & Jet blast





Runway extension – Component 5 Perimeter road & fencing






Runway extension – Component 5 Shoreline protection

HVAC Chiller System Upgrade

Project Scope

- Evaluation and upgrade of the existing HVAC system
- Improve thermal comfort at problematic areas and at the western end of the terminal building

Project Status

- Contract executed May 2017
- Project scheduled to be completed by February 2018
- Location for the chillers and the associated equipment to be located south of the Main Terminal adjacent to the staff car park
- Equipment for the project including the chillers and air handling unit is on order and awaiting delivery


