MBJ AIRPORTS LIMITED AUTOMATING SANGSTER INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT PUBLIC CAR PARK

Montego Bay, Jamaica, 03 December, 2019 // MBJ Airports Limited is implementing an automated payment system for the public car parks at the Sangster International Airport. This is in keeping with MBJ's mandate to modernize processes to improve efficiency and continue SIA's journey to becoming a world-class facility.

System testing will commence in the coming weeks.

The public is advised to note the following steps when utilizing the payment system:

- 1. Parking tickets will be issued by the ticket machine at the entrance to the parking lot.
- The ticket must be kept on your person, as you will be required to make payment before
 returning to your car. Once payment has been made, you will have up to 15 minutes to exit
 the parking lot.
- 3. Payment is made at any of three designated Pay Stations located by Door 4 at Departures, by Arrivals, or within the parking lot.
- 4. Payment is completed using a 4-step process:
 - a. Step 1 scan the barcode on the ticket at the designated area on the Pay Station.
 - b. Step 2 insert money at the designated area on the Pay Station.
 - c. Step 3 A receipt will be issued. **Keep this receipt** as you will need it to exit the parking lot.
 - d. Step 4 Collect your change, if receiving any.
- 5. The Pay Stations will **only** accept 50, 100 and 500 dollar notes plan accordingly.
- 6. To exit the parking lot, you will need to scan your receipt at the ticket machines located by the exit barriers. The receipt is scanned with the barcode side facing up.
- 7. Users have up to 15 minutes following payment to exit the car park failure to exit within this time period will result in the ticket remaining open and incurring parking charges.
