SANGSTER INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT CONTINUES NORMAL OPERATION

Montego Bay, Jamaica, 28 January 2020.

Operations at the Sangster International Airport (SIA) have not been impacted by the earthquake that occurred approximately 110 km off Jamaica's northwest coast on January 28, 2020 at approximately 2 p.m. local time. MBJ will continue to monitor the situation and provide the necessary updates.

Please see excerpt from the advisory issued by the Office of Disaster Preparedness and Emergency Management (ODPEM); 'Tsunami threat level is low as the plate movement was sideways. However, persons should: (i) avoid beach area (ii) be alert for changes in wave action along the coast and (iii) prepared to move to higher ground should the situation warrant.'
