Frontier Airlines Expands Connections from the United States to Jamaica with commencement of new services from Atlanta and Orlando.

Montego Bay, Jamaica, 2 November 2021// Sangster International Airport (SIA), Jamaica's leading gateway to the world operated by MBJ Airports Limited, welcomed Frontier's direct flights from Atlanta and Orlando.

Low fare carrier Frontier Airlines, flight F9 #17 arrived from Hartsfield–Jackson Atlanta International Airport (ATL) on Monday, November 1 at 8:39 a.m. with 42 passengers and from Orlando International Airport (MCO) – on Tuesday, November 2 at 2:09 p.m. with 68 passengers. The thrice weekly services will operate from Atlanta on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays, and from Orlando on Tuesdays, Thursdays, and Sundays. The two (2) new routes represent Frontier's third 3rd new route addition to MBJ in seven (7) months following the airline's launch of three (3) weekly service from Miami in May 2021.

The inaugural flights were met with a spectacular water salute from MBJ's Emergency Response Service firefighting units, while the melodious sounds of Jamaican Mento music performed live by Music & Love Band permeated the atmosphere as ecstatic passengers disembarked. Domestic & International Sales Manager of Frontier, Alfredo Gonzalez arrived on the inaugural flight for the celebration. Also, in attendance to greet the passengers and crew were Deputy Mayor of Montego Bay, Councillor Richard Vernon, Chair of the Jamaica Hotel & Tourist Association, Montego Bay Chapter, Nadine Spence, Odette Dyer and Francine Carter of the Jamaica Tourist Board, Joy Roberts of Jamaica Vacations Ltd and representatives from MBJ.

Audley Deidrick, President & CEO, Airports Authority of Jamaica congratulated the MBJ team and Frontier on the new services launched this week. "These additional airline service will give our aviation and tourism industry a boost as we continue to recover from the COVID-19 Pandemic. I look forward to their successful operation on the routes."

MBJ Airports Limited's Chief Executive Officer, Shane Munroe is also pleased with the addition of this new service, stating "We are thrilled with Frontier's expansion of non-stop services into Montego Bay, Sangster International Airport.
