## AMERICAN AIRLINES LAUNCHES NEW DIRECT SERVICE FROM AUSTIN, TEXAS TO MONTEGO BAY, JAMAICA

Montego Bay, Jamaica, 04 2022// Sangster International Airport (SIA), Jamaica's leading gateway to the world operated by MBJ Airports Limited, today welcomed American Airlines (AA) inaugural once weekly scheduled service on Saturdays from Austin, Texas, USA.

The inaugural flight using an Embraer 175 aircraft with capacity of 76 persons was met with a water salute from MBJ's Emergency Response Service firefighting units. Government officials including Minister of Tourism, Hon. Edmund Bartlett and Deputy Mayor of Montego Bay, Richard Vernon, were in attendance to greet the 66 arriving passengers and crew. Senior Jamaica Tourist Board, Airport officials, other tourism partners and media were also present.

Disembarking passengers were greeted by live performance of from a Jamaican Mento band and Jamaican memorabilia was presented to the crew by the Jamaica Tourist Board.

In welcoming the flight, Hon. Minister Bartlett indicated that "summer 2022 will be the strongest summer that Jamaica's tourism has ever seen, exceeding 2019 figures."

American Airlines is excited about the addition of this new service. "As we celebrate our 45th anniversary in Jamaica, we are thrilled to continue strengthening our presence with new service between Austin and Montego Bay, and in just a few months with the launch of our third destination in the island, Ocho Rios." said Jose Maria Giraldo, American Airlines' Managing Director for Mexico, Central America and the Caribbean. "These new flights will complement our robust Jamaican footprint, including up to 15 daily flights this summer."


