Frontier Airlines Begins Nonstop Service from Montego Bay to Chicago, Denver and St. Louis

MONTEGO BAY, Jamaica - February 24, 2023 - Ultra-low fare carrier Frontier Airlines (NASDAQ: ULCC) launches seasonal nonstop service this week from Sangster International Airport in Montego Bay (MBJ) to Chicago Midway International Airport (MDW), Denver International Airport (DEN), and St. Louis Lambert International Airport (STL). With the new service, Frontier serves a total of nine nonstop destinations from MBJ. Frontier is also the only carrier connecting MBJ to DEN with nonstop service.
