## **Tropical Storm Warning in effect for Jamaica**

- Sangster International Airport Remains Operational

Montego Bay, Jamaica: October 23, 2025 - 11:00 A.M.

A Tropical Storm Warning is now in effect for Jamaica.

Based on the bulletin released by the Meteorological Service of Jamaica on Thursday, October 23, 2025, at 8:00 a.m., which details the predicted path of Tropical Storm Melissa, **Sangster International Airport** (SIA) remains open and operating normally at this time.
